



The OPAL program complies with CFR 192.615, CFR 195.402 and 195.403 for emergency responders and public officials. The current program includes:

- API RP 1162 baseline outreach to emergency responders and public officials
- Presentations, classes, and engagement with emergency responder and public official at industry conferences*
- Virtual and face-to-face meetings with emergency responders and public officials**
- Capabilities surveys for participating agencies
- 24/7 online awareness training for emergency responders and public officials
- Reciprocal memberships with Oklahoma emergency and safety organizations
- Operator and emergency responder access to PAPA training materials
- Excavator and agriculture outreach through conferences
- Safety Day trainings for excavators and emergency responders in partnership with OKIE811
- Grants that provide education and equipment to emergency response agencies

Exclusive OPAL program benefits:

- Pipeline emergency response initiative (PERI) supported by PHMSA
- Partnership with Oklahoma Fire Services Training (OSUFST) and Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET) to provide multiple levels of certified training
- New in 2023: The Oklahoma Haz-Mat Conference in partnership with OSUFST and The Department of Homeland Security

All members receive documentation at the end of the calendar year. The documentation is organized in several formats to better assist our members with audits.

*Travel to multiple meetings for several months is not ideal for our members, so we work collaboratively to attend conferences where we educate emergency responders and public official on behalf of all members.
